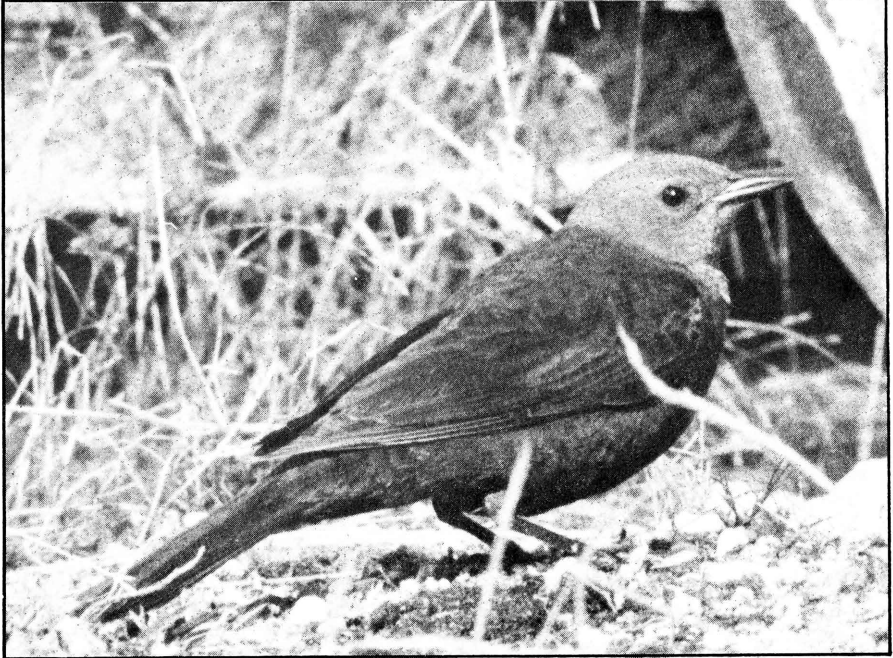


## Photo Quiz
