The status of Craveri's Murrelet *Synthliboramphus craveri* and reoccupation of a former nesting area, published in *Marine Ornithology* 39 (2011), pages 269–273. On page 270, in the right-hand column, the last sentence of the second paragraph should read:

San Pedro Martir supported introduced black rats *Rattus rattus* from the late 1800s until 2007, when an eradication program was successful (Samaniego-Herrera *et al.* 2009).
