

**Maryland Christmas Counts (116th CBC)
December 2015 through January 2016**

Low temperatures averaged 33.8 °F (1.0 °C) across all Maryland counts (n = 24), and highs averaged 49.3 °F (9.6 °C). There was a minimum low of 19 °F (-7.2 °C) at Oakland, a maximum low of 56 °F (13.3 °C) at Point Lookout, a minimum high of 26 °F (-3.3 °C) at Oakland, and a maximum high of 73 °F (22.8 °C) at Point Lookout. The only winter precipitation noted was a light snow at Oakland with a maximum of 1 inch (2.5 cm) on the ground. Some compilers noted warmer temperatures at many counts and this could have contributed to slower birding, but also could have been partly responsible for sightings of some unusual birds.

Count names, abbreviated codes, survey dates, and compilers (including co-compiler) are presented in Table 1. Additional effort data (field counters, numbers of parties, party hours and miles, feeder counters and hours, and night hours and miles) are also tabulated (Table 2). The count with the most field counters was Seneca with 111 and the count with the fewest was Allegany County with 10. Seneca also had the most party hours (305.7), but fewer party miles (469.44) than Bowie (603.15), Annapolis-Gibson Island (596), Sugarloaf Mountain (582.5), Chesterville (567.05), Ocean City (523.6), and Rock Run (493.6).

Mega-highlights were a **Lazuli Bunting** (Figure 1) at Ocean City and a **Vermillion Flycatcher** (Figure 2) at Chesterville. There were also a few unusual wintering warblers. Seneca reported two **Chestnut-sided Warblers** and even four **Golden-winged Warblers**. Both species were well described and a single **Chestnut-sided Warbler** was photo-documented in subsequent searches for these birds. Crisfield had a **Nashville Warbler**. Ocean City had a **White-eyed Vireo** and a **Yellow-breasted Chat**. There were also a **Barrow's Goldeneye** and an **Eared Grebe** on the Point Lookout count. Chesterville had a **Loggerhead Shrike**. Middle River had a **Blue-gray Gnatcatcher**. Six Maryland counts had **Baltimore Orioles** (Bowie, Annapolis-Gibson Island, Middle River, Jug Bay, Lower Kent County, and Ocean City).

The inland counts are summarized in Table 3; the tidewater counts, in Table 4.
