

BIRD CALENDAR FOR 1924

Bulletin No. 2.

March 24 – April 28

The unusually cold, late spring has delayed bird migrations as well as vegetation and flowers. But on the whole, the dates of the arrivals of our annual spring visitants of the feathered tribe have not been as much later than usual, as the almost continuous cold weather and winds throughout the month of March might have led us to expect. While certain common birds, such as song sparrows, blue birds, and robins appeared in Cleveland considerably later than usual; others like the mourning dove were observed remarkably early this year.

Some sorts of birds again, have been observed in unusually large numbers during the last three or four weeks; while others have been notably scarce. Robins, flickers, song sparrows, juncos, brown creepers, chickadees, downy woodpeckers, white-breasted nuthatches, mourning doves, ruby-crowned and golden-crowned kinglets, cedar waxwings, bronzed grackles, and redwinged blackbirds; as well as several varieties of ducks have been seen in remarkably great numbers. On the other hand blue birds, chewinks, and vesper sparrows have been comparatively scarce. Mr. W.J. Baker saw some 10,000 redwinged blackbirds early in the morning of March 30th in a marsh at Sandusky. "They made a thin, undulating line," reports Mr. Baker, "rising and falling about the marsh for a quarter of a mile." The same observer reports "about 1500 ducks and 200 swans inside the Fairport breakwater" on April 1st. Miss Calfee of the College for Women has had the good luck to see one of those rare freaks of nature, a white robin, for two years in succession. She saw the bird this year on the 26th of March at 2755 Berkshire Rd., Cleveland Heights.
