

BIRD CALENDAR - 1929 - 25th YEAR

Bulletin No 3 - May 5 - June 5

The number of birds reported this year is larger by about ten than that of any year since the Calendar has begun. This has resulted mainly from the larger number of interested observers reporting regularly. Moreover, the unusually cool, extended spring has helped somewhat by making it agreeable for certain kinds of migratory birds to linger longer than usual in and around Cleveland. There have been two distinct migratory movements this spring, the one centering about the warm days of early April, the other about the "hot spell" in the last days of May. The sudden changes in temperature accompanied by cold wind following the last "hot" day of each warm period, apparently caused many birds, such as Warblers, to move on to parts where the climate was more agreeable. Nevertheless, 29 Warblers have been reported since the last week of April, the largest number ever reported in any previous year. The Warblers recorded are, with the date each was first reported; Black and White (May 4), Blackburnian (May 11), Bay-breasted (May 11), Black-throated Blue (May 1), Black-throated Gray (May 17), Black-throated Green (April 27), Black-poll (May 11), Cerulean (May 23), Blue-winged (May 11), Canada (May 11), Cape May (May 11), Chestnut-sided (May 11), Golden-winged (May 11), Mourning (May 11), Hooded (May 25), Magnolia (May 1), Maryland Yellow-throat (May 1), Mourning (May 11), Myrtle (May 5), Nashville (April 27), Northern Parula (June 4), Ovenbird (May 10), Prairie (May 11), Prothonotary (May 25), Redstart (May 6), Tennessee (May 11), Wilson's (May 11), Yellow-breasted Chat (May 19), Yellow (May 1).

This list does not include several warblers which were reported last year or in immediately preceding years, such as Connecticut, Kentucky, Palm (and Yellow Palm), Pine, Swainson's, Worm-eating. The Myrtle Warbler has generally been first reported not later than the third week of April. This Warbler has been seen comparatively seldom in and around Cleveland this year, though it has been one of our most familiar, as well as the earliest comer, of the Warbler family for several years.
