Information wanted: Mr. Arthur Aronoff, 59 West 71st St., New York 23, N. Y., is making a study of the color phase inheritance in screech owls. He is most interested in the following information about nesting birds: (1) Color phase of the male, female and each offspring. (2) Approximate relative abundance of the two phases in the general area in which each nest is found. (3) Color and family part played by any individual that is known to have been involved either as nestling or parent in more than one nesting, and the specific nesting records in which that individual was involved.
