During the course of this experiment the bird banding office had a lot of trouble trying to make it clear that the "34" or "36" did not, after all, indicate the year in which the bird had been banded. It could be added that the examples of banded birds given above indicate only the pair in which the band was used; not the year in which the band was issued.

Eventually three digit prefixes came into use with the third digit indicating the band size. Maybe in years to come it will be necessary to see letters again.
