Mary Schmid reports the following films will be shown:

During the Workshop Sessions:

"Nature's Birds of Prey" - a Hawk Mountain film.

"Marsh Harvest" - the story of waterfowl migrations told and filmed by Bill Carrick, one of Canada's foremost wildlife photographers.

"Behind the Flyways" - A F & WS film of ducks and geese nesting, in flight, and being banded.

After the Banquet:

"The Canada Goose" - Ducks Unlimited's international award-winning film.

"The Whooping Crane" - A F & WL film taken mostly at Arkansas National Wildlife Refuge.

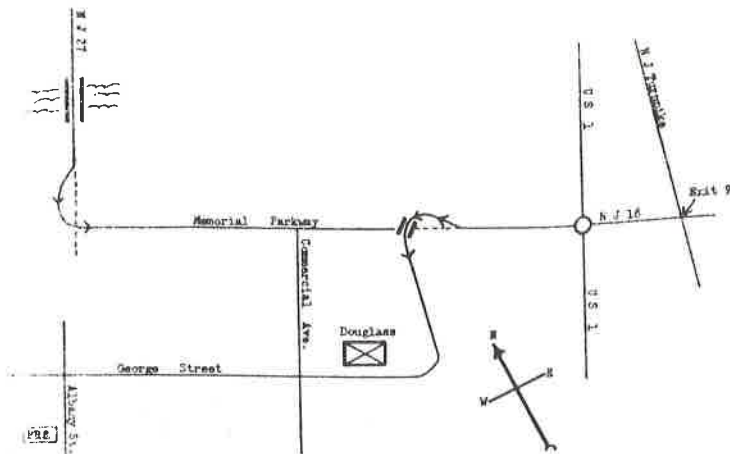
TO REACH DOUGLASS COLLEGE Via US Highway 1 -- turn to New Brunswick at interchange of this highway with NJ 18. Approx one mile, bear right from NJ 18 onto overpass (marked George St.) and into George St. which passes through Douglass Campus.

Via N.J. Turnpike - leave turnpike at Interchange 9, taking NJ 18 across US 1. Then as above.

By other routes from south and west - drive to center of New Brunswick (George & Albany Sts.) and proceed on George St.

By other routes from north and east - on NJ 27 keep right when crossing Raritan River bridge, entering lane marked "Route 18 and Shore Points" which leads onto NJ 18.

Note - Disregard "To Rutgers University" highway markers. They direct to Rutgers divisions not including Douglass College.



Below is a partial map of the Douglass College Campus. Registration and reception is in the Student Center (No. 10); rooms are in Jameson (No. 23); Saturday morning meeting will be in Jameson Auditorium (No. 22); Workshop sessions will be in the Botany Building (No. 4); meals in Cooper Hall (No. 9).
