WHITE-CROWNED SPARROW INFORMATION WANTED

This item gives you information which I think may be somewhat unusual pertaining to the White-crowned Sparrow (Zonotrichia leucophrys).

From January 15, 1964 through February 29 I banded 7 sub-adults (this classification after 1-1-64.) This species was casual to my observations until approximately the winter of 1962. Since 1962 the species seems to be increasing in numbers during the winter and spring migration. It is also interesting from my point of view that all my bandings were sub-adults.

I would appreciate any advice as to other available information concerning the White-crowned Sparrow.
