### EVENING GROSBEAK RECOVERIES

On January 12, 1964 while banding in the Oxford, Michigan area, I captured 12 Evening Grosbeaks in a drop type trap.. Two of the twelve were already banded, both of them were females.



The first bird was banded on December 18, 1960 at Walker, Minnesota.

The second bird was banded on October 28, 1963 at Cedar Grove, Wisconsin. It is interesting to note that this bird was banded on the western shore of Lake Michigan and in less than three months was recovered on the eastern side of the State of Michigan.
