

EBBA ANNUAL BANDING SUMMARY - 1969

The Table below gives totals of birds banded in 1969, by species for states and provinces in the eastern region, as reported to EBBA. In this second annual compilation, the number of banders reporting and total birds banded both were up about 25% over last year. The totals are based on Reports received from 277 banders residing in the 17 eastern U.S. states (and 2 Canadian residents), representing over one-third of the 728 U.S. master banding permittees, and more than half of the 524 permittees other than game management agents and state Fish

and Game Departments. Most of those who band large numbers of non-game birds are included. Except for waterfowl and Mourning Doves, the statistics probably incorporate considerably more than half of all birds actually banded in the eastern states in 1969.
