THE 1971 EBBA ANNUAL MEETING.....How to get there....

EBBA's 48th Annual Meeting will be held on April 30, May 1 & 2, 1971 at Charleston, South Carolina. A pre-registration form was enclosed with the previous issue of EBBA News.

By Air: Charleston is served by four airlines: Eastern Airlines, National Airlines, Delta Airlines and Piedmont Aviation.



Following is a list of cities and the carriers which can be boarded there for your meeting destination. We suggest that you contact the company listed at once:

Atlanta: Delta; Birmingham: Delta; Boston: Eastern; Chicago: Delta & Eastern; Cincinnati: Delta & Piedmont; Miami: National; Newark: National; New York(JFK Airport): National; Norfolk, Philadelphia and Providence: National; Washington, D.C.: Eastern & National.

By Car: From the North: Direct Route: Via Washington, D.C., Route 95 to Florence, S.C., then Rt. 52 to Charleston. Scenic Route: Via the Delmarva Peninsula and the Norfolk-Chesapeake Bay Tunnel/Bridge, Rt. 13/17 along the coast, most of the way, to Charleston.



From the South: From Miami, Rt. 95 to Florida state line, then Rt. 17 to Charleston.

From the West: Nashville, Tenn. Rt. 40 to Ashville, N.C., Rt. 26 to Charleston; From Pittsburgh, Penna. Turnpike to Exit 12, Rt. 70 to Washington, D.C., then as above. From Birmingham, Rt. 20 to Augusta, Via Atlanta. Rt. 1 to Aiken, S.C., then to Rt. 26 via Orangeburg, S.C. We hope we'll meet many Inland Bird Banders at our meeting.

Local: The airport is located about 11 miles from the Charleston Business Center. Limousine service from the airport discharges passengers directly in front of the Orvin Inn, the meeting headquarters motel.
