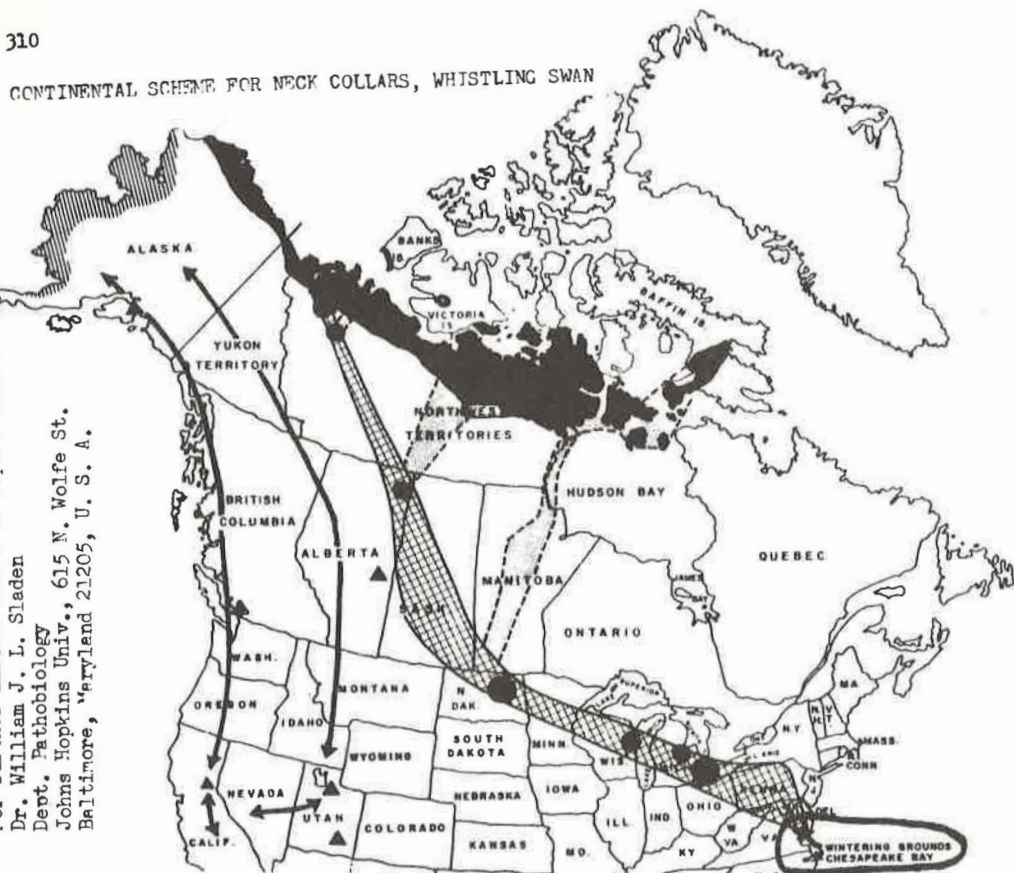

KEY With Color of Neck Collars

-  Eastern Population Wintering Grounds (BLACK) - Md., Va., N.C.
-  Eastern Population Migration Route (YELLOW).
-  Probable Routes followed by swans leaving main route for breeding grounds in Eastern & Central Canadian Arctic.
-  Major resting/feeding grounds (Eastern population)
-  Breeding grounds Northwest Territories (RED) and Alaska (BLUE) of Eastern population.
-  Breeding grounds Alaska (BLUE) of Western population.
-  Suggested major routes for Western population and wintering grounds (GREEN).
-  Recoveries of Western Alaska swans.
