We do not accept submissions dealing with "listing" and we discourage Seasonal Reports of bird sightings as these are covered by Bird Finding in Canada and American Birds, respectively. Distributional records of species for which the Ontario Bird Records Committee (OBRC) requires documentation must be accepted by them before they can be published in Ontario Birds.
