## WBBA Annual Report of Birds Banded, 2014

There were 169 Master Banders reporting 135,756 banded birds. This was a 15+% decline in the number of birds reported, but an increase of eight reporting banders. One reason for this discrepancy is that almost 50% of the reporting banders banded a single species, and the number reporting banders who banded 25 or more species was the lowest in my tenure as compiler. There were 532 taxa (including BBL-recognized species, subspecies, hybrids, and a few unknowns) banded, 22 more than last year. As in the past, this is mostly due to bird banded in Mexico.

**Some highlights:** the three leading birds banded were game birds (Mallards with 6437 banded, Mourning Doves with 6416 banded, and Canada Geese with 4772 banded). This year again, we have Manuel Grosselett with Tierra de Aves in Oxaca, Mexico, whose banders banded 21,400 birds in 175 taxa, including 3378 Gray Catbirds, 3231 Yellow-breasted Chats, 2427 Yellow Warblers, and 2195 Orchard Orioles. In the western states, Robert Meese banded 4505 Tricolored Blackbirds, while studying the precipitous decline in this species in California in recent years.

Although the western states are going through a massive, unprecedented drought, banding for most taxa and areas seem to close to the numbers from previous years. The leading birds banded listed above were had higher number than 2013. California, hardest hit by the drought, had ~8000 more banded birds than 2013.

A good portion of the lower number of banded birds seem to be due to a decline in reports from hummingbird banders and Canadian banders. I am not quite sure of the "why" for hummingbirds, but I think there were some communication issues between CWS and myself, where requests for annual banding summaries did not get out. For those who missed the boat, I obviously can not "add" your numbers to the published totals, but I can add your numbers to the version posted on the Western Bird Banding Association website.
