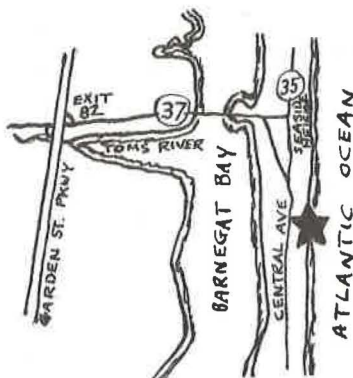
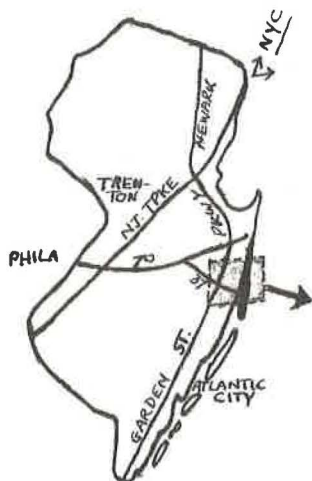


## HOW TO GET TO THE ANNUAL MEETING AT ISLAND BEACH, NEW JERSEY.

From Pennsylvania or points south: N.J. Turnpike to EXIT 4. Then Rt. 70 East to Lakehurst, onto Rt. 37 as on map.

From New York, take Garden State Pkwy to Exit 82; see map. Follow signs for Island Beach.

BY BUS

From New York City, there are busses to Toms River. Contact NY Port Authority Bus Terminal in Manhattan for information on schedules and bus companies involved.

BY AIR

Fly to Philadelphia International Airport. From there take Salem Limousine Service to Lakehurst; disembark at Eisenhower Bar.
