Vireo nelsoni Bond.—In my paper on the systematic position of the genus *Lawrencina* and *Laletes* (Proc. Acad. Nat. Sci. of Phila., Vol. LXXXVI, 1934, pp. 399–402), I united the former with the genus *Vireo* and, in a footnote, proposed the name *Vireo nelsoni* for the Michoacan Vireo (*Vireo nanus* Nelson). I omitted, however, to give a definite published reference as required under Article 25 of the International Code. The basis of my name *Vireo nelsoni* is *Vireo nanus* Nelson, Proc. Biol. Soc., Wash., 12, p. 59, 1898, Type, from Querendaro, Michoacan, Mexico, in collection of U. S. National Museum, Washington, D. C.—JAMES BOND, *Academy of Natural Sciences of Philadelphia.*
