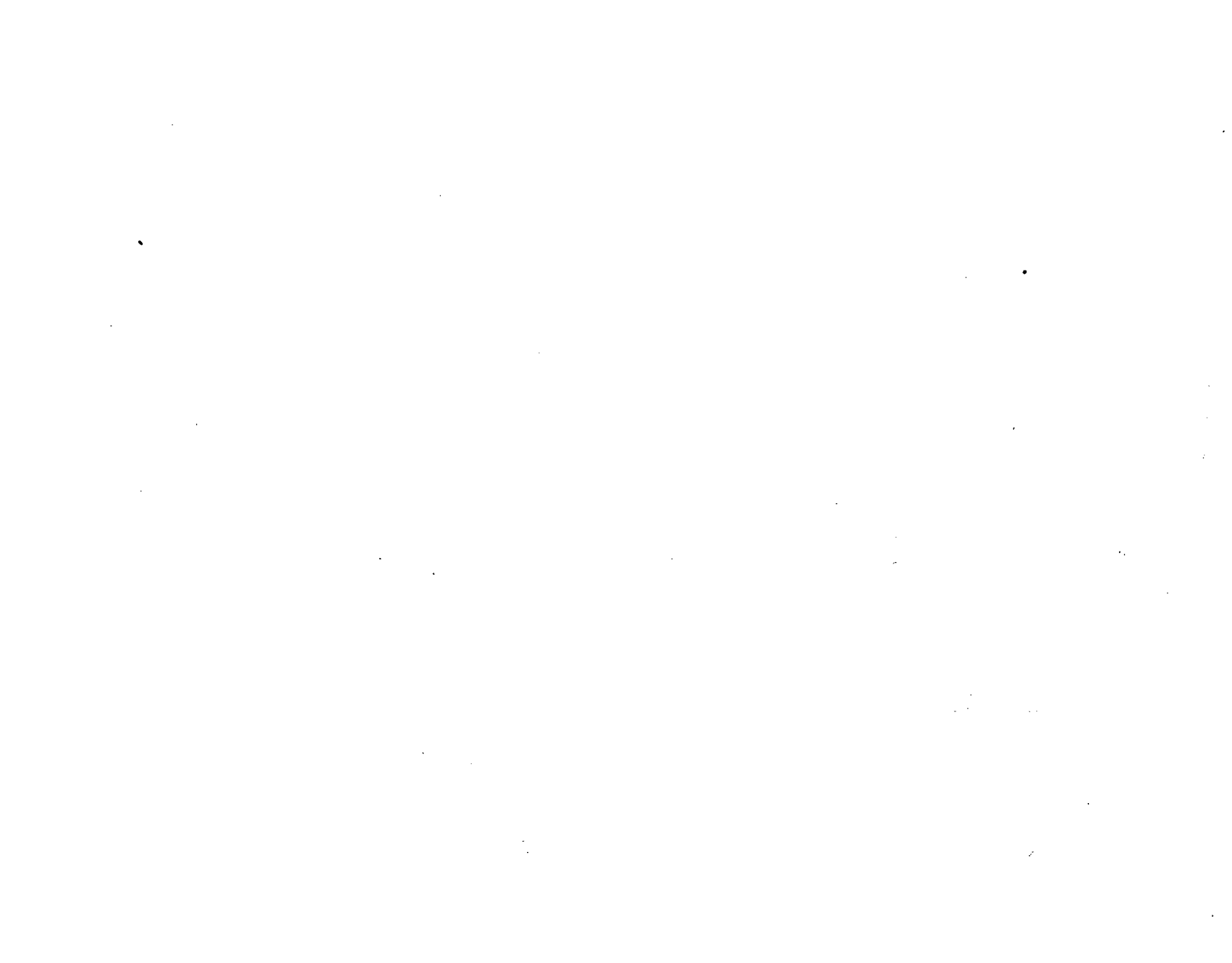

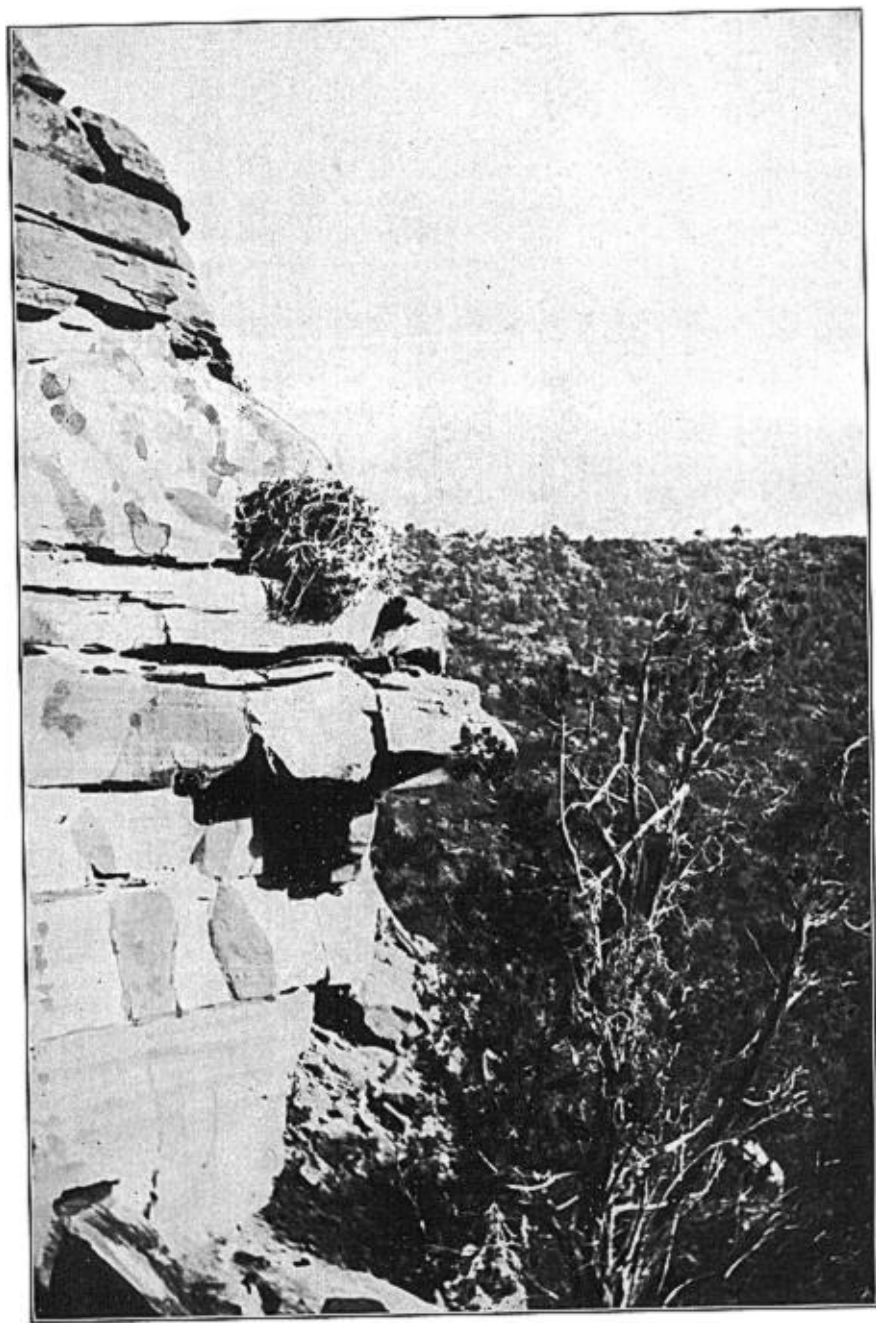


Fig. 18. AN ANCESTRAL EAGLE'S NEST ON THE LLANO WALL.
