Although considerable work was done in the higher portions of the Olympic Mountains by the Biological Survey party of 1921, Leucostictes were noted on but three occasions. On August 3, 1921, we saw perhaps half a dozen birds on Dodwell-Rixon Pass, between the Snowfinger Glacier at the head of the Elwha River and the headwaters of the Queets River; on August 5 a flock of nine individuals was observed on the ridge between Mounts Noyes and Seattle (altitude about 5,500 feet); and on the same day I collected three immature birds on a rocky ledge above Elwha Basin at an altitude of some 5,000 feet. Two young Rosy Finches were on a steep side-hill near waterfalls and glaciers, and quite obviously belonged to a single family which had apparently been reared in the immediate vicinity.--Walter P.
