The following bibliography lists ornithological books published in any language in 1992 and not listed in my previous bibliography in *The Condor* (95:245-250). Most U.S. and Canadian government documents are not listed in this bibliography. My annotations enclosed in brackets are intended to clarify the content of the publications. Despite trying to make this and the previous bibliography as complete as possible, I am sure that I omitted many ornithologically significant publications. Therefore, I would be grateful if readers of *The Condor* inform me of ornithological publications (1) that I omitted so that I may include them in future bibliographies, and (2) that are published in the future, in any language, to insure that they will be cited in future bibliographies.
