Robertson et al. - in the period October 1978 to April 1979 at Werrabee and Seaford swamp, Port Phillip Bay, Victoria, Australia are: 29 Pied Oystercatchers Haematopus ostralegus, 5 White-headed Stilts Himantopus himantopus, 2 Red-necked Avocets Recurvirostra novaehollandiae, 3 Double-banded Plovers Charadrius bicinctus, 55 Red-capped Plovers C. alexandrius, 3 Mongolian Plovers C. mongolicus, 20 Red-kneed Dotterels Erythrogonys cinctus, 13 Lesser Golden Plovers Pluvialis dominica, 10 Masked Lapwings Vanellus tricolor, 90 Red Knots Calidris canutus, 3643 Red-necked Stints C. ruficollis, 348 Sharp-tailed Sandpipers C. acuminata, 1047 Curlew Sandpipers C. ferruginea, 21 Latham's Snipes Gallinago hardwickii, 1 Terek Sandpiper Xenus cinereus, and 4 Ruddy Turnstones Arenaria interpres.
