Catches of the Victorian Wader Study Group in Victoria, Australia, in the period July to December 1980 were:

2 Grey Plovers, 4 Red-kneed Dotterels *Erythrogonys cinctus*, 13 Double-banded Plovers *Charadrius bicinctus*, 13 Red-capped Plovers *C. ruficapillus*, 2 Red-necked Avocets *Recurvirostra novaehollandiae*, 1 Turnstone *Arenaria interpres*, 5 Latham's Snipes *Gallinago hardwickii*, 34 Bar-tailed Godwits, 4 Red Knots, 15 Great Knots *Calidris tenuirostris*, 289 Sharp-tailed Sandpipers *C.acuminata*, 2342 Red-necked Stints *C.ruficollis*, 1 Long-toed Stint *C.subminuta* and 1 Curlew Sandpiper.
