The Editor of *Bird-Banding*, and the officers of The Northeastern Bird Banding Association Incorporated, who jointly are responsible for the publication of this lone North American journal dealing with ornithological investigation through the ringing technique, regret very much the disruption in the orderly appearance of *Bird-Banding*. In order to continue publishing the journal without increasing the price, the printing work was transferred from the Boston area to the Kraushar Printing Co., in Northampton. This company in turn recently sold out completely to the Metcalf Printing Co., also of Northampton, Massachusetts. We are looking forward to a long association with this latter firm, and an orderly procession of worthwhile issues of *Bird-Banding* appearing on scheduled publication dates.
