NOTES AND NEWS

At the annual meeting of NEBBA on October 29, 1966 it was voted that all individual subscribers be considered members of the Association, leaving only institutions as subscribers to Bird-Banding. Individuals will of course continue to receive the journal, but their \$5 annual payment will be considered to be dues rather than a subscription. The previous distinction between individual members and individual subscribers had no real meaning after the annual charge became a minimum of \$5 for all (to meet increases in printing costs).

The October 29th meeting featured a series of short papers by members on their research projects, to illustrate ways in which amateurs can focus their efforts on specific problems rather than applying bands at random.

NEBBA'S spring field meeting will be held at Pleasant Valley Wildlife Sanctuary (of the Massachusetts Audubon Society) at Lenox, Mass. on May 20, 1967. It will feature a demonstration of mist nets (weather permitting), traps, and other banding equipment. Other features are being discussed, such as a tentative session on warbler identification.
