Significant Encounters

Most of the following records were reported by western banders who submitted the Annual Summary reports for 1990 and 1991 to the the Western Bird Banding Association. Banders that do not contribute to this summary (including those in EBBA and IBBA) may submit records directly to this column; see *NABB* 14:14 for guidelines used to distinguish significant records.

The following records are presented to highlight interesting recoveries and recaptures that have resulted from banding projects. We hope the reports show how different banders are using the data generated through their projects. Some of the records reported here, such as the longevities, may be significant advances in our knowledge. For a listing of longevity records verified by the Bird Banding Laboratory, see the papers cited in Klimkiewicz and Futcher (1989) *J. Field Ornithol.* 60:469-494.

Trumpeter Swan 619-11282 and 559-21028 Banded and marked with neck collars as L-M and L-F by Terry Doyle at Northway AK on 12 Sept 1989. Resighted at Sedro Woolley WA on 15 Dec 1990, <u>about 2200 km SE of banding site</u>.

Canada Goose 598-44486 Banded as HY-U by Mike Fisher at Grays Lake NWR, ID on 10 July 1974. Shot on the Paiute Reservation UT on 19 Dec 1990, <u>16 years old</u>.

... 528-99709 Banded as AHY-F by staff of Medicine Lake NWR, MT on 27 July 1977. Shot at Lisco NE on 14 Dec 1990, <u>about 500 km SE of banding</u> <u>site. 14 years old</u>.

... (Aleutian race) 997-14214 and 997-14319 Banded as SY-F and ASY-F by Paul Springer at Crescent City CA on 29 Mar 1977 and 2 Apr 1978, respectively. Both resighted there on 29 Mar and 23 Mar 1989, respectively. [**New longevity record** for Aleutian race. 14214 was 13 years, 9 months old, 14319 was at least 12 years, 9 months old. Neither was resighted in 1990. See *NABB* 12:173 for description of this race's previous record and *J. Field Ornithol.* 60:474 for species as a whole.] **Mallard** 2317-33179 and 1507-47309 Banded in Alberta Canada in Aug 1989. Trapped in swim-in trap at Grays Lake NWR, Wagon ID by staff of the refuge on 30-31 Aug 1991, <u>at least 640 km S of</u> <u>banding site</u>.

776-54478 Banded as SY-Mon 29 Mar 1988. Shot near San Fernando, Mexico on 7 Nov 1989.

1006-08399 Banded as AHY-F on 26 Sept 1989. Shot near Los Benos, Tamaulipas, Mexico on 26 Nov 1989, <u>at least 1700 km SE of banding site</u>.

Steller's Eider 647-64547 Banded as U-M (at least TY) by Christian Dau and staff of the Izembek NWR at Izembek Lagoon AK on 1 Sep 1976. Recaptured there on 10 Sep 1992. <u>At least 19 years. 3 months old</u>. [New longevity record, previous record was 14 years, 3 months, see *J. Field Ornithol.* 60:476. 64547 is oldest of Dau's 156 recoveries and 603 recaptures.]

... 1157-01787 and 1157-01876 Both banded as AHY-F (at least TY) by Christian Dau and staff of the Izembek NWR at Izembek Lagoon AK on 15 Sep 1979. Recaptured there in Sep 1992. <u>At least 16 years old</u>.

Harlequin Duck 655-07239 Banded as L-F by R. Wallen at Grand Teton Nat. Park WY on 24 Aug 1985. Recaptured there on 8 June 1990. 5 years old. [**Longevity record?** Species not included in recent longevity compilations by Clapp, Klimkiewicz and coworkers.]

Osprey 608-62302 Banded by John Gregoire in Croom MD on 25 Aug 1985. Found dead in Jamaica on 25 Nov 1985, <u>at least 2100 km S of</u> <u>banding site</u>.

Bald Eagle 629-32100 Banded as ATY-F by Al Harmata at Hauser Lake MT on 15 Nov 1990. Struck powerline and died near Cascade MT on 18 Feb 1992. [Bird was aged as being in 4th year when banded, so 6 years old when killed. Only one leg when first banded.]

Killed by collision with large truck there on 29 Feb 1992. <u>12 years. one month between banding and recovery dates</u>. [Bander estimates age at death as 17+ years, since bird was full adult (\geq 5 years) when banded. Close to longevity record of 17 years, 1 month, see *J. Field Ornithol*. 60:477.] American Kestrel 1493-53667 Banded as L-F by Lowell McEwen and Brett Peterson in Gooding Co. ID on 12 July 1988. Found dead in Jalisco, Mexico on 27 Jan 1989, <u>about 2400 km SE of banding site</u>.

Prairie Falcon 1807-1286 Banded as L-U by M.N. Kochert near Grand View ID on 17 June 1991. Hit powerline in Brock Saskatchewan on 12 Aug 1991, about 1200 km NE of banding site.

...816-74764 Banded as L-U by M.N. Kochert near Grand View ID on 27 May 1991. Hit by car in Alliance NE on 6 July 1991, <u>about 1050 km E of</u> <u>banding site</u>.

Black Oystercatcher 495-65644 Banded and colorbanded as prob TY-U by Gary Falxa at Bodega Head, Sonoma Co. CA on 18 Jan 1989. Resighted at Trinidad Head, Humboldt Co. CA on 27 June 1990, about 330 km N of banding site.

California Gull 825-23367 Banded as L-U by Ronald Ryder at Antero Reservoir CO on 29 June 1985. Found dead at Humboldt Bay CA in Aug 1989, <u>about 1600 km W of banding site</u>. 4 years old.

Sabine Gulls 1433-31501 and 1433-31507 Both banded as ASY-U by Tom Pogson and James Helmincks in the Colville River Delta AK on 26 July 1983 and 27 July 1983, respectively. Recaptured there on 3 July 1990. <u>At least 9 years. 1 month old</u>. [**Longevity record?** Species not included in recent compilations by Klimkiewicz, Clapp and coworkers. Pogson reports 3 other birds at least 8 years old, 2 birds at least 7 years old, and 1 bird at least 6 years old.]

Western Screech-Owl 745-51152 Banded as HY-U by Carole Sheridan at Tacoma WA on 2 Sept 1981. Hit window and released there on 4 Aug 1990. 9 years old. [Hand-raised bird, encountered < 8 km from banding site.]

Northern Saw-whet Owl 704-15226 Banded as L-U by Ray Cromie at Ardrossan AB on 15 June 1989. Found dead in farmer's yard in Camrose AB on 24 Feb 1990, about 65 km S of banding site. **Calliope Hummingbird** t-15717 Banded as HY-U by Barbara Carlson in the San Bernardino Mtns. CA on 17 July 1990. Netted in Sonoita AZ on 12 Sept 1990, <u>about 700 km E at banding site</u>.

Broad-tailed Hummingbird x-50345 Banded as AHY-M by Steve Den at Padre Park CO on 2 May 1987. Renetted there on 27 May 1990. 4 years old.

... 2010-60296 Banded as AHY-F by Merlin Killpack at Odden UT on 10 Jan 1985. Recaptured there on 21 Feb 1991. At least 7 years old.

Common Redpoll 1810-58522 Banded as ASY-M near Charlesbourg PQ on 10 Apr 1988. Retrapped by Jackson Whitman at McGrath AK on 1 Apr 1990, about 5100 km NW of banding site.

American Goldfinch 1830-83788 Banded as ASY-M by John Gregoire at Kestrel Haven Farm, Burdett NY on 9 May 1991. Captured by Kathy Klimkiewicz at Laurel MD on 5 Jan 1992, about 600 km SW of banding site. [The winter recovery occurred on the grounds of the Bird Banding Lab. The goldfinch was later recaptured by Gregoire back at Kestrel Haven Farm on 8 May 1992.]
