
WBBA Annual Meeting

We hope you can attend the 1997 Annual Meeting, 2-5 October 1997, at Ash Meadow National Wildlife Refuge in Nevada just across the state line from Death Valley National Park in California. Accommodations will be at Pahrump, NV, about 60 miles west of Las Vegas. The site is easily accessible by car from southern California. Las Vegas has direct flights from many North American cities.

The meeting will feature demonstrations of equipment and field techniques at a time when fall migrants should still be present.
