EBBA is pleased to announce the availability once again of **polyester** mist nets to qualified banders. Polvester has the advantage over nylon of being more water resistant, thus sagging less when wet with rain or dew, and is more sun resistant, leading to longer net life.

These nets have the added advantage of **deep bag** afforded by netting that is 200 vertical meshes deep In the 1 1/4-in mesh size (50% more meshes than conventional nylon), and 150 meshes in the 1 1/2-in size. Deep bag improves capture and holding of birds in nets, and 1 1/4-in mesh size facilitates removal because of less tangling.

All are 75-denier, two-ply thread, tethered for wind protection, and 2.9 m (9.4 ft) in height. They are available as follows:


