Green Co., Pa., S. R. rare. One nest 6-6-'91. 5 eggs.

Oswego City, N. Y., S. R. common.

There is an unauthentic record for Grinnell, Iowa, and one for Lorain Co., O. "Not uncommon along Lake Michigan as a migrant, less common in the interior" (of Wisconsin). (L. Kumlein.)

Sylvania pusilla (Wils.) WILSON'S WARBLER.

Garden City, Kan., one taken in spring of 1891.

Jackson Co., Mo., T. V.

Grinnell, Iowa, T. V. common. Often abundant in Sept.

Meridian, Wis., T. V. not common.

Lorain Co., O., T. V. rare. One taken 5-21-'91 by G. D. Wilder.

Oswego City, N. Y., T. V. rare.

Portland, Conn., T. V. common.

"Not uncommon as a migrant. Undoubtedly breeds in Wisconsin." (L. Kumlein.) More of us should be acquainted with this interesting little fellow.
